GUIDELINES

1. The challenge is for Carroll County students in grades K-12 to interpret and express what “green” means to them. Students will compete within their grade level and will be eligible for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place ribbons, along with the *Student Artist of the Year* award for 1st place winners.
2. **All artwork must be submitted by April 1, 2010, 4pm at the Carroll County Arts Center.** Each student can submit one original piece of artwork that was completed during the current school year.
3. **Students should NOT have their name on the front of the artwork.**
4. **Each student must have a completed Student Registration Form attached to the backside of the artwork.** Use the form provided which contains:
 - Student Name, Address & Phone Number
 - Student Grade, School & Teacher
 - Title of artwork (if applicable), Medium
 - Parent/Guardian Approval - REQUIRED**
5. Artwork must be no larger than 18”x24” and may be rendered on any type of surface. **All artwork must be matted and framed with wire on back ready to hang.** Three dimensional work of a “reasonable for display” size may also be submitted. Photography and computer generated images will not be accepted.
6. There will be no entry fee charged for student participation although **each student must have their parent or guardian approval.** Entries without this approval will not be accepted.
7. Student work must remain on exhibit for the duration of the show and must be claimed during the week following the show. All artwork unclaimed after 30 days from the show ending will become the property of the Arts Center to donate or dispose of at the discretion of the Center.
8. Carroll County Arts Center reserves the right to photocopy student artwork for the purpose of advertising or promotional needs for the Center at any time.
9. All artwork needs to comply with the Arts Center and school guidelines for appropriateness. Artwork that is not acceptable in the school district, due to policy and practice, is not acceptable at the Arts Center for the student show.

JUDGING

Artwork submitted to the 2010 Student Art Show will be judged on the following criteria:

- CREATIVITY Artwork demonstrates original thinking and expressive artistic perceptions.
- COMPOSITION Artwork demonstrates a unique and sensitive way of solving artistic problems. It illustrates the student's understanding of and ability to interpret the elements of art and principles of design.
- TECHNIQUE Artwork demonstrates student's competency in using the medium to achieve the desired outcome.
- ORIGINALITY Artwork may be done as a part of the student's art class but must be completely done by the student and original in design.

There will be a minimum of three judges. The Art Center will ensure no conflict of interest in the judges, i.e. art teachers as judges will be from another county or school system. We will use a system that does not identify the students or schools until the judging is complete. **Students should not have their names on the front side of their work. Please use the form provided and attach to the back of the artwork.**

RECEPTION

The Awards Reception honoring the winners and their families, teachers, and friends will be held at the Carroll County Arts Center on Sunday, May 9, 2010 from 1:00pm - 4:00pm. Winners will announced at the reception where they will receive their award(s). It is hoped that all winners will be in attendance to receive their awards and have their pictures taken for the local newspapers. Awards times will follow the posted schedule:

K-5 Grade – awards will be presented at 1:30pm

Music will be provided from 2:00pm - 2:45pm

6-12 Grade – awards will be presented at 3:00pm

Please plan to arrive during the scheduled time to alleviate crowding.
